

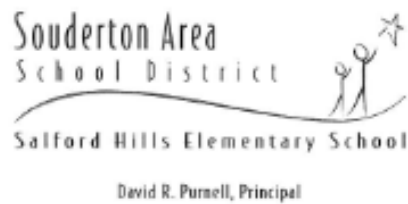

Suggested Kindergarten Supplies

Classroom supplies will be provided for you. Listed below are OPTIONAL supplies if you would like to purchase some of your own materials to bring with you on the first day of school:

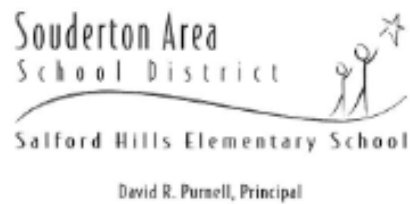
- Colored Pencils
- Manual pencil sharpeners
- Crayola Pip-Squeak markers
- Glue sticks
- Sanitizing Wipes
- 2-gallon Ziploc bags
- Art Smock in a Ziploc bag with your child's name on it (the smock can be an old large shirt)



Suggested **First Grade** Supplies

Classroom supplies will be provided for you. Listed below are **OPTIONAL** supplies if you would like to purchase some of your own materials to bring with you on the first day of school:

- Book bag (not rolling), labeled with your child's name
- 8-pack of glue sticks (we share supplies)
- 1-2 boxes of No. 2 pencils (sharpened if possible)
- 3-ring binder (not a trapper keeper)
- Small pencil/supply box
- 24-pack of crayons
- Expo Dry Erase markers (4-8 markers)
- Tissues
- Clorox wipes
- Sandwich or gallon size "Ziploc" bags
- Ear buds or headphones in a "Ziploc" bag (labeled with your child's name)
- Large old T-shirt in a "Ziploc" bag (labeled with your child's name)



Suggested **Second Grade** Supplies

Classroom supplies will be provided for you. Listed below are **OPTIONAL** supplies if you would like to purchase some of your own materials to bring with you on the first day of school:

- Pencils (LOTS)
- 3 Large Glue sticks
- Scissors
- Colored pencils/crayons
- 2 Expo dry erase markers and an old sock to erase
- Erasers
- A small pencil box
- Art smock in a labeled Ziploc bag
- Ear buds in a labeled baggie

Suggested **Third Grade** Supplies

All of your school supplies will be provided for you. We share all school supplies with each other. This helps to build community, and the students see the classroom and the supplies in it as "ours". If you would like to contribute supplies to our classroom/team the following list of supplies might be helpful. These items are useful in doing many of our classroom activities:

- No. 2 lead pencils

- yellow highlighter
- 1 marble composition book

- 2 glue sticks
- erasers - pencil top
- smock in a bag (labeled)
- ear buds

- 2 boxes of tissues
- Expo Markers

- Yellow Highlighters
- #2 Pencils
- Three 8 x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ Spiral notebook wide ruled (not college ruled)
