- Smock in a Ziploc bag (labeled with name)

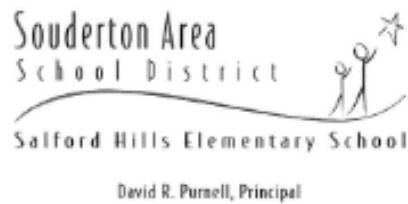
